UNITED STATES BICYCLE ROUTE SYSTEM SUPPORT FOR UNITED STATES BICYCLE ROUTES 66 AND 95

The American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials has initiated a national effort, led in this State by the Adventure Cycling Association, the California Department of Transportation, and the California Bicycle Coalition, with a goal to provide a nationwide network of bicycle routes across the United States using roads and trails. Public Works recognizes that bicycle tourism is growing and that our region will benefit from supporting it both economically and from the public health and environmental related benefits of increased bicycle travel.

Public Works supports the designation of United States Bicycle Route (USBR) 66 through the unincorporated County community of East Pasadena along Colorado Boulevard between Kinneola Avenue and Michillinda Avenue. We also support the designation of USBR 95 through the unincorporated County community of Marina Del Rey along the Marvin Braude Bike Trail from Pacific Avenue to Washington Boulevard.

We request that the California Department of Transportation submit the USBR 66 and USBR 95 routes for the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials designation as soon as this can be achieved.
